Have a Safe Adventurous Summer

As the temperatures rise and the days seem longer you know summer is upon us here in the cove; And with Summer comes vacation for most! Travelling can be great but it can also make you vulnerable to fraud or even identity theft. Here are some things you can do to help lower those risks.

- 1.Reduce What You Carry- Before going on vacation clean out your purse or wallet. Remove all unnecessary cards. Carry nothing with your Social Security Number on it.
- 2.Take Extra Precautions in Tourist Areas-These areas are favorites for card skimming as well as purse snatchers. Try using a small crossbody purse so you never have to take it off and carry your cards in a RFID protected wallet.
- 3. Avoid Using Public or Shared Computers- They could have information stealing software in place.
- 4.Leave Your Checkbook at Home-Your checks have a lot of useful information that criminals want. Including, name, address, bank name, and account number. A better option for extra cash would be a travel card that you can get right here at the credit union. It allows you to put a certain amount of funds on a card so if stolen, criminals can only get a specific amount.

5. Verify Callers to Your Hotel Room- A common scam these days involves a call to your hotel room from, "The Front Desk," stating there is a problem and they need your credit card information right over the phone. If this happens hang up and visit the front desk.
